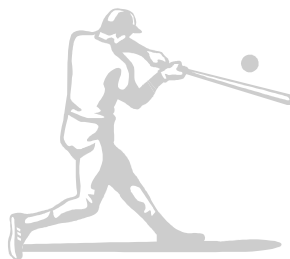

The "five-tool player" evaluation is the gold standard by which players are measured. However, most talent scouts agree that all five tools can only be found in a handful of players within *professional* baseball. Most of the game's players don't have all five tools. Even still, every player who desires to excel in the game (no matter what level) must work hard at all five tools of the game. Five-Tool Baseball Camp isn't about identifying whether or not a player is a "five-tooler." Rather, it is about challenging players to work hard on the essential tools that make baseball the most challenging game you'll ever love.
