



## **EBLL AAA Second Season**

**GOAL:** To provide EBLB 9 yr old players an opportunity to play additional games and rotate into new positions and play against kids their own age. Coaches should strive to provide equal playing time to all players and give players an opportunity to play new and different positions and learn new skills. We did this for the 9 yr olds the last few years and the kids had a great time.

**TEAMS:** Coaches are to solicit the players on their teams for sign-ups. Depending on the sign-ups we will try to keep teams intact. However, we may have to combine some teams and/or split-up some teams and ARBITRARILY re-assign players to achieve workable numbers on each team.

### **PLAYER ELEGIBILITY:**

- All of this year's AAA 9 yr olds are eligible to play. 10's are allowed but focus is for the 9's.
- Minors 8 kids are allowed to play up to fill a roster spot however the child should be "ready" for kid pitch as we would not like to have any kids nervous for the AAA season the next year.
- Players are encouraged to sign up even if they can't make some of the games due to vacations, camps, other activities as the teams will typically have 13 players to account for absences.

### **COST:**

- There is a \$20.00 charge for 2010 regular season EBLB players. The \$20 should be given to your 2<sup>nd</sup> Season coach for umpire fees.
- Cost may include cost of balls

### **REGISTRATION:**

- Fill out the below form.
- Contact your current coach.
- Coaches will turn into the Second Season coordinator.

### **SCHEDULE:**

- Each team will be scheduled to play 2 games per week tentatively starting around July 20<sup>th</sup> and finishing August 27<sup>th</sup> for at least 8 games per team.
- Coaches may have an initial practice for the kids to get to know each other a little. There will be no mandatory practices!!!
- Games will be played on Tuesday and Thursdays. Time of games will be dependent on the number of teams, start time is most likely 5:30pm.
- Scheduling of make-up games is up to the coaches and can be scheduled through the Second Season Coordinator.

### **UMPIRES:**

- Home Plate and field umpire will be assigned. If no field umpire, recruit a volunteer Field umpire. NOTE: any adult involved in the game in any way must have filled out a Volunteer form during the regular season, so it is best to have a coach or assistant from the regular season.

### **UNIFORMS & PLAY:**

- Players use the same pants, socks and hats from regular season.
- Coaches will bat continuous order. Meaning, all kids playing with the team will bat.
- The person on deck and does not get a bat will be the 1<sup>st</sup> batter in the next game.
- There will be no scoreboards, no standings.

### **SECOND SEASON COACHES:**

- Will consist of a combination of some regular season coaches as well as other interested parents or volunteers.
- New volunteer coaches will need to complete a Volunteer form, which is located on EBLB.org.
- It is the responsibility of each coach to pay each umpire. Any remaining funds after the season is over will be distributed back to the team parents.

### **REGULAR SEASON COACHES RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Regular Season Coaches are responsible to solicit their players. Coaches, without exception, (including Tournament Team Coaches) are to return the attached Second Season Interest Roster to the Second Season Coordinator no later than the prescribed turn in date.
- Coaches for the regular season will be turning in their equipment and Second Season Coaches will be issued equipment.
